Crossroads is a church without a box. We welcome teams with various skills to meet the spiritual needs while meeting the physical needs of those in the area. Teams assist with evangelism and outreach.

1. The Lord's Café (free restaurant ministry) provides free meals to the community and free groceries. During the school year, hot meals are prepared Monday and Friday; the grocery giveaway is held on Wednesday. Approximately 120 eat lunch each day and over 100 families receive free groceries each week. In the summer months, The Lord's Café operated four days a week for lunch and Wednesday for grocery giveaway. In the summer, as many as 250 lunches are served each day. Teams assist with preparing the meal, cleaning, serving as wait staff, bus station and dishwashers, and more. The Lord's Café operates completely by donation and volunteer help. This ministry proves God can still multiply food.

2. Teams assist local faith family with ongoing outreach ministries to children in the area through The Learning Center. During the school year, Kidz Korner provides after school activities for elementary school age. In the summer, Day Camp operates all day Monday through Thursday. Teams assist in teaching, worship, recreation, and crafts. We provide the curriculum for the lessons and lunch for the children. We also have a summer staff to facility the administrative duties.

3. Construction teams are needed for tiny home construction (The Light Community) and facility updates and repair. All skill levels needed.
4. Teams participate in laundry ministry, adult day care, block parties, hair and nail salon, sports camps, clothing ministry and other outreach projects.
5. Other opportunities are available.

**Ministry Description:**

Crossroads Community Baptist Church started as church plant in 2010. Crossroads provides an ongoing outreach of food, clothing, educational support, and more. - replace/repair flood lights on exterior of Abidings 1-4

- check and repair anything necessary on our low ropes course
- build new elements for team building
- remove water fountain in Lodge

- Removal of existing metal roof
- Replace bad plywood decking with new
- Install two layers of 1.5 poly iso insulation board
- Install a new white .060 mil TPO roof system with all related flashing

The estimated cost of the job is \$55,975 and the church does not have funds for this project.

**Ministry Description:**

Gospel Community Church is a Kentucky Baptist Convention church plant to reach the Deaf (4<sup>th</sup> largest unreached people group on the planet). GCC is one of only 39 churches in the United States planted to reach over 7.5 million unreached Deaf people. Although a large majority of the congregation is Deaf, blind, otherwise disabled, and the bulk of the congregation live below the poverty line, the church is growing. By the grace and providence of God, GCC was able to purchase its own building in 2017. That is, to their knowledge, the first Deaf church of its kind to have its own self standing facility.

This past year they stepped out in faith and began demo and first phase of renovation. Week after week, teams of volunteers torn down walls, pulled out insulation, cut pipe, and framed up holes. They pursued a small manageable

loan to finish up the needed build out and faithfully continued to work. This past week the snow, and the weight of the melting snow on the roof, caused 2 small cave-ins. The resulting water damage flooded the building and destroyed about \$10,000 worth of drop ceiling they were storing for use in the new building. All of the donated contractors agree that getting the building securely water-tight and under-roof has to happen before the building work can restart.
