Additional brief supporting data, ministry program reports, background and need, community profile (population served), past evaluations, and other helpful information may be attached.

Deadline: Applications for 2018 funding must be received on or before **April 1, 2018**

Funding period: The funding period will be **April 1 – December 31, 2018**.

Applications should be submitted for one year of funding. Funds will be distributed based on need and availability of funds.

No application, no funding.

Eligibility Criteria: To be eligible to receive funds from Appalachian Mountain Ministry, ministries must be endorsed or sponsored by one of the following: a local Southern Baptist church; a local Southern Baptist association; or a SBC state convention.

All Offering funds must be used for hunger relief and/or development. Applicants are encouraged to apply for funds for ministries that help people move out of poverty as well as for ministries that meet immediate needs. Applicants also are encouraged to fund ministries that utilize volunteers.

Evaluation/Reporting: Organizations and ministry programs receiving funds from Appalachian Mountain Ministry will submit regular reports regarding its ministries. Funding recipients must also be open to occasional site visits by Appalachian Mountain Ministry.

Accountability: Your state convention will periodically receive a report from Appalachian Mountain Ministry identifying those receiving funding and the amount received.

All donated funds will be handled through the Georgia Baptist Mission Board. Appalachian Mountain Ministry does not solicit funds.
